Guidelines for Use of Emmaus Scholarship Funds

Mt. Pisgah UMC Mission Branch

January 11, 2012

Goal: Funds collected for the Emmaus Scholarship will be used to help sponsor Emmaus/Chrysalis “Pilgrims” or “Caterpillars” for The Walk to Emmaus and Chrysalis Flight weekends.

Applicant guidelines:

- Applicants wishing to sponsor a Pilgrim/Caterpillar will be members or active visitors at Mt. Pisgah UMC.
- Applicants will need to explain under “comments” on the application why they need financial assistance from the Scholarship funds to pay the registration fee for a Pilgrim or Caterpillar.
- Applicants will be asked if they have previously received Emmaus scholarship funding and, and if so, when and how much.
- Applicants will turn in an application to the Mission Branch Emmaus representative for approval. The Mission Branch will designate an Emmaus representative, and an Emmaus committee consisting of that representative and other Mission Branch Scholarship committee members.
- The Emmaus Scholarship committee will determine approval of a scholarship request, and approved scholarships will be awarded by the Mission Branch Emmaus Scholarship representative.
- Emmaus Scholarship representative will fill out the proper paperwork to transfer the funds, and the Treasurer will write the checks.
- Partial scholarships will be taken under consideration for those applying for some help, but not the whole amount.
- All funds must be returned if sponsored applicant does not attend the Walk to Emmaus/Chrysalis Flight he/she was scheduled to attend.
